

The Temple Emunah COVID Guidelines / Updated 6/15/2021

The health, safety, and well-being of employees, congregants, and community are of primary importance to Temple Emunah.

As the situation evolves, we will continue to update our policies.

All people 16 and older who enter the building must be vaccinated. Children 15 and under may or may not be vaccinated. Adults and children must wear a mask at all times except when leading services. For outdoor events, vaccinated and unvaccinated adults and children are welcome. Masks must be worn outdoors as well.

All events and services require registration.

If you have any of the COVID related symptoms, you may not attend indoor or outdoor events at Temple Emunah, regardless of vaccination status.

Anyone who comes onto Temple property must do the following:

Wearing a mask covering both your nose and mouth at all times is mandatory while on Temple property, including the parking lot. Drinks and food may not be consumed in the building.

Maintain social distancing at a minimum of three to six feet at all times.

Notify the office if you develop any symptoms or are exposed to someone who develops symptoms and/or tests positive for COVID within two (2) weeks after visiting the building.
